## What is World Life Institute Project Life?

A federally registered 501(c)3 organization that provides official receipts for financial donations by individuals, businesses, and congregations. A New York State tax exempt organization that holds a Certificate of Authority. Form ST-121available to vendors as needed.

World Life Institute Project Life was launched in 1997 and since then has sponsored more than 135 international war orphans, some with complex medical needs, to summer programs in western New York. Our headquarters is on West Center Street in Medina.

Ahmed Cherif is a 9-year-old boy from Tunisia in northern Africa. He suffers from a complex array of medical issues that could not be addressed in his home country. He came to Medina, N.Y. with his mother a year ago seeking help and looking for a healthy future. Project Life is assisting in providing support to Ahmed and his mother.

### How will my donation be used?

You can help by pledging a regular monthly amount, or by giving a one-time gift toward the following expenses for Ahmed and his mother:

\$400 per month for pharmacy and home health supplies not covered by insurance

\$100 per month for recreation and transportation

\$400 per month for nutritious food

\$650 per month for rent and utilities

\$50 per month for school supplies, toys, and activities for Ahmed

\$75 per month for clothing and shoes

\$45 per month for parking at the hospital

We also need your help to develop a contingency fund for occasional expenses such as dental care, eye care, and the cost of immigration paperwork.
